Tegla Loroupe Peace School

he Foundation has established a peace school in Kapenguria that is intended to host 600 pupils in a boarding school. The school will act as a center that promotes education, recreation and build children's capacity to excel in sports.

The construction began in 2005 and at the moment, a one storey tuition block containing 16 classrooms is complete and with the 10 classrooms already occupied, with 216 children already in school.

The school offers the following:

- Educational opportunities to children displaced and or orphaned by conflict and HIV/AIDS in the pastoral communities
- A rescue centre for girls at risk from female genital mutilation, early/forced marriages by giving them a safe haven.
- Enable children unlearn the war values and the enemy attitude by mixing children from various warring communities and nations
- A peace education syllabus as part of its overall teaching curriculum
- Gives parents from various warring communities an opportunity to interact
- A training facility for the talented youth from these communities.

The school building was built by Tegla Loroupe with the help of the following sponsors, who will also help her to finance and inspire other people to support more school children in her Peace school.
